

# Petition Calling for Late Night Trains

To the Honourable Speaker and Members of the Legislative Assembly in NSW, this petition of the people of New South Wales brings to the attention of the House:

Kings Cross has serious congestion problems late at night on weekends, with thousands of people visiting the precinct. Research identified 7,500 people an hour using Darlinghurst Road on Saturday nights, with similar numbers in Bayswater Road. Lack of transport contributes to alcohol-related violence and anti-social behaviour late at night when trains don't run, there are few taxis and limited NightRide bus services. The City of Sydney has identified that 24 hour train services on Friday and Saturday nights would help improve safety and amenity. Kings Cross needs to be treated as a major event on weekends – with the necessary infrastructure. The Government needs to provide late night transport to service the late night economy.
