Petition Calling for New Inner City Ferries

To the Honourable Speaker and Members of the Legislative Assembly in NSW The petition of the people of New South Wales brings to the attention of the House:

The government's 'Sydney's Ferry Future' strategy released in May 2013 identified the need for new ferry wharves and ferry services to Barangaroo, Glebe Point, Johnston's Bay Pyrmont, Woolloomooloo and Elizabeth Bay. Work is well underway to provide services to Barangaroo, but we've not seen the feasibility studies and community consultation needed for the other locations. Meanwhile inner city populations and traffic congestion around the city continue to increase. The community urgently needs realistic public transport options to replace private motor vehicles. Ferry wharves and services could help address transport needs for Glebe Point and Blackwattle Bay, Johnston's Bay and the Pyrmont peninsula, Woolloomooloo and Elizabeth Bay.

The undersigned petitioners therefore ask that the Government fast-track project work for ferry wharves and services at Glebe Point, Johnston's Bay Pyrmont, Woolloomooloo and Elizabeth Bay.
