

NSW GUIDELINES ON THE RECOGNITION OF SEX AND GENDER

To the Honourable the Speaker and Members of the NSW Legislative Assembly, the petition of NSW residents brings to the attention of the House that in 2013, the Commonwealth Government introduced guidelines to help protect citizens from discrimination on the basis of sexual orientation, gender identity and intersex status.

These guidelines ensure that government recognises that individuals may identify as a gender other than the sex they were assigned at birth, or may not identify as exclusively male or female, and that this should be reflected in records held by the government.

We the undersigned ask the Legislative Assembly to call on the Government to adopt these guidelines at the State Government level, to remove discrimination against residents of diverse sexuality or gender.
