

Petition Calling for the NSW Government to Retain Inner City Social Housing

To the Honourable the Speaker and Members of the Legislative Assembly in New South Wales in Parliament assembled.
This petition of the people of New South Wales brings to the attention of the House:

Inner Sydney housing is increasingly unaffordable, and there are very long waiting lists for social housing close to jobs, transport, and health and welfare services. The government sold 99 year leases on Housing NSW homes in Millers Point, Dawes Point and The Rocks, and is now selling all but 28 units in this precinct.

Inner city public housing is necessary to provide housing and help to our most vulnerable citizens, close to transport, support services and jobs.

The undersigned petitioners therefore ask the government to retain and maintain inner city public housing stock.
