The Petition of the residents of South Western Sydney in and around the Suburbs of Liverpool, Campbelltown and Camden – Within and around the State electorates of Holsworthy, Liverpool, Macquarie Fields, Campbelltown, Camden and Mulgoa

Brings to the attention of the House the Urgent need for Multi-Level Car Parking facilities and a better Bus service at Edmondson Park and Leppington Train Stations and the Car Parking Stress experienced at other Train Stations along the Macarthur Line including Holsworthy, Glenfield and through to Campbelltown Station to cope with the current and future demand of Commuters in the Area.
