To the Honourable the Speaker and Members of the Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled.

The Petition of the residents of South Western Sydney in and around the Suburbs of
Liverpool, Campbelltown and Camden known as the Liverpool and Macarthur Region.

Brings to the attention of the House the lack of adequate Public Transport from the suburbs
of Middleton Grange, Hoxton Park, Greenway Park, Carnes Hill, Horningsea Park, Bardia,
Edmondson Park, West Hoxton, Hoxton Park and Austral Areas to the Edmondson Park and
Leppington Train Stations. This is a problem as the Stations do not have enough car parking
infrastructure to cope with current and future demand from Commuters causing major
overflow of car onto the roads in the surrounding areas.

The undersigned petitioners therefore ask the Legislative Assembly to provide more Buses
(including Night Ride Services) to the Stations and to Construct Multi Level Car Parks at
Edmondson Park and Leppington Train Stations as a matter of urgency in order to
accommodate for the current demand for commuter demand of trains and parking and
provide for future demand as the areas continue to grow. This will allow the ever increasing
number of commuters to use public transport safely and securely.
