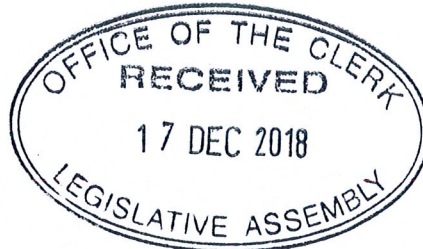

I write in response to the petition lodged on 13 November 2018 by Mr Paul Lynch MP, Member for Liverpool, regarding commuter parking at Leppington Station.


The NSW Government delivered free parking for more than 1,200 cars when it built the South West Rail Link at Edmondson Park and Leppington Stations.

Funding has been allocated in the 2018-19 Budget for a review of car parking along the South West Rail/Leppington Line and the T8 South Line to determine the best places for car parking to serve the south-west area.

Transport for NSW continues to investigate short, medium and long term options to alleviate commuter parking issues at Leppington Station and other stations in the region. These options may include optimising land use near stations, formalising car parking spaces and/or construction of new commuter car parking spaces. They also include further expansion of the On Demand bus service and additional active transport infrastructure, such as pedestrian and bicycle paths.
