

20 ORDER FOR PAPERS—MURRAY RIVER TO BROKEN HILL PIPELINE

Mr Field moved, according to sessional order: That private members' business item no. 62 outside the order of precedence be considered in a short form format.

Mr Field, by leave, amended private members' business item no. 62 outside the order of precedence as follows:

1. Omitting "35 days" and inserting instead "42 days".
2. Omitting "1 July 2014" and inserting instead "1 January 2014 to 30 June 2016".
3. Omitting ", Treasury, the Treasurer, the Minister for Regional NSW, Industry and Trade and the Minister for Water, Property and Housing".
4. Omitting "paragraph (a)".

Mr Field then moved, according to notice, as by leave amended: That, under standing order 52, there be laid upon the table of the House within 42 days of the date of passing of this resolution the following documents created since 1 January 2014 to 30 June 2016 in the possession, custody or control of the Department of Planning and Industry:

- (a) all documents relating to the assessment of the nineteen project options referred to in the June 2016 Department of Primary Industries document entitled, "Pipeline to secure Broken Hill's water",
- (b) the final business case for the Murray River to Broken Hill Pipeline, and
- (c) any legal or other advice regarding the scope or validity of this order of the House created as a result of this order of the House.

Debate ensued.
