

STOP CANGAI MINE

To the Honorable President and Members of the New South Wales
Legislative Council in Parliament Assembled

The signatories to this petition are residents and visitors to the Northern Rivers and New England who wish to draw the attention NSW Parliament to the fact that **mineral exploration is occurring at the historical Cangai Copper Mine site and Kungabarin Hill of the Clarence Valley.**

- If mining were to proceed, it would **impose unacceptable risks to the health of local waterways**, specifically the **Mann River, Clarence River** and their tributaries, which are home to **rare and endangered flora and fauna**, and are **vital to the health of our fishing, farming and tourism industries.**
- **Traditional landowners** of this region, the **Gumbaynggir, Yaegl and Bundjalung** people have strong connections to these lands and are **united behind this petition.**
- The undersigned petitioners, therefore, ask the Legislative Council to **stop exploration or mining within the Clarence Valley and surrounding local government rea.**
