Ms Boyd moved, according to sessional order: That private members' business item no.1690 be considered in a short form format.

Question put and passed.

Ms Boyd, by leave, amended private members' business item no. 1690 by omitting "21 days" and inserting "35 days" instead.

Ms Boyd moved, according to notice, as by leave amended: That, under standing order 52, there be laid upon the table of the House within 35 days of the date of passing of this resolution the following documents created since 6 June 2019, in electronic format if possible, in the possession, custody or control of the Treasurer and Minister for Energy, Treasury, Minister for Environment and Heritage or the Department of Planning and Environment relating to contamination at power station associated sites:

- (a) all documents, including correspondence, relating to contamination at sites associated with operations at the following power stations, for which the State may be liable at any time in accordance with the terms of its sale of those power stations:
 - (i) Mount Piper power station,
 - (ii) Bayswater power station,
 - (iii) Liddell power station,
 - (iv) Vales Point power station,
 - (v) Eraring power station,
 - (vi) Munmorah power station,
 - (vii) Redbank power station,
 - (viii) Wallerawang power station, and
- (b) any legal or other advice regarding the scope or validity of this order of the House created as a result of this order of the House.

Debate ensued.
