

40 ORDER FOR PAPERS—GREYHOUND RACING INDUSTRY SURVEY

Ms Sharpe (on behalf of Mrs Houssos) moved, according to sessional order: That private members' business item no. 1787 be considered in a short form format.

Question put and passed.

Mrs Houssos moved, according to notice: That, under standing order 52, there be laid upon the table of the House within 14 days of the date of passing of this resolution the following documents created since 1 January 2021 in the possession, custody or control of the Minister for Hospitality and Racing, the Department of Customer Service, the Office of Racing or Greyhound Racing NSW relating to the Greyhound Racing Industry Survey:

- (a) all documents, including emails, briefings, text messages and memorandum, relating to the Greyhound Racing Industry Survey conducted by Insightfully in November 2021, and
- (b) any legal or other advice regarding the scope or validity of this order of the House created as a result of this order of the House.

Debate ensued.

Ms Boyd moved: That the question be amended as follows:

- (1) Insert "or Greyhound Welfare and Integrity Commission" after "Greyhound Racing NSW",
- (2) Insert after paragraph (b):
 - "(2) That the Clerk communicate the terms of this resolution to Greyhound Racing NSW and the Greyhound Welfare and Integrity Commission."

Debate continued.
