

19 ORDER FOR PAPERS—MINISTERIAL CODE OF CONDUCT

Order of the day read for resumption of the interrupted debate of the question on motion of Mr Graham: That, under standing order 52, there be laid upon the table of the House within 21 days of the date of passing of this resolution the following documents, excluding any documents previously returned under an order of the House, created since 1 July 2019, in the possession, custody or control of the Premier, Office of the Premier and the Department of Premier and Cabinet relating to disclosure obligations under the Ministerial Code of Conduct:

- (a) all documents relating to any submission or application made by a Minister or parliamentary secretary in respect of satisfying their disclosure obligations under the Ministerial Code of Conduct,
- (b) all documents relating to rulings made by the Premier of the day in relation to any disclosures made by a Minister or parliamentary secretary in respect of satisfying their obligations under the Ministerial Code of Conduct, and
- (c) any legal or other advice regarding the scope or validity of this order of the House created as a result of this order of the House.

Upon which Mr Tudehope has moved: That the question be amended by inserting at the end:

"(2) That this House calls on the NSW Labor Opposition to disclose the diaries of their Shadow Ministers."

Question put: That the amendment of Mr Tudehope be agreed to.
