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*Armaments: Prohibition of Public Lecture:* There being an opportunity within a reasonable time during the debate on the Budget to discuss the action of the Chief Secretary in prohibiting the Hypatia Club's hearing a lecture and discussing traffic in armaments, a motion under standing order 49 is out of order, *adj.*, 406.

*Australian Iron and Steel Limited, Industrial Dispute:* It being a well-established rule that Parliament should not discuss a matter which is the subject of proceedings before a Court, a motion, the terms of which relate to questions which are at the moment the subject matter of inquiry by the Industrial Commission is out of order, 2239.

*Maritime Services Bill:* The giving of notice under standing order 175B is not "business" within the meaning of the sessional order which provides that after a certain fixed time no other business may be entertained, 679, 680.

*Public Services Salaries (Judges) Amendment Bill:* An attack upon a judge, except on a specific motion, will not be permitted, 2007.

*The Budget:* In Committee of Ways and Means, the Chairman having ruled upon a point of order, he reported to Mr. Speaker the point of order, which was: That the Chairman was wrong in allowing the Hon. the Premier to discuss the propriety of hon. members of this House making statements and speeches in the House under privilege relating to the operations of the Milk Board and the possibility of subsequent abuse of such Parliamentary privilege by the republication of such speeches whilst a certain civil action is pending before the Supreme Court of New South Wales—such case being set down for hearing to-morrow, and in which the issue largely concerns statements made in this House by an hon. member under cover of privilege. Notwithstanding what had transpired in Committee, Mr. Speaker is only called upon to decide the point of order as referred by the Committee to the House, and that is whether the Chairman was right in permitting the Premier to make the comments referred to in the statement of the point of order now before him. The decision of the Chairman was quite correct, 1515.
