“Board” means the Chiropodists Registration Board constituted under this Act.

5 “Chiropodist” means a person registered under this Act.

“Chiropody” means the care of the toe-nails or the treatment of their disorders or the treatment of superficial excrescences of the feet.

“Member” means a member of the Board.

“Prescribed” means prescribed by this Act or by the regulations.

10 “Register” means the register of chiropodists under this Act.

“Regulations” means regulations under this Act.

“Secretary” means the secretary to the Board.
