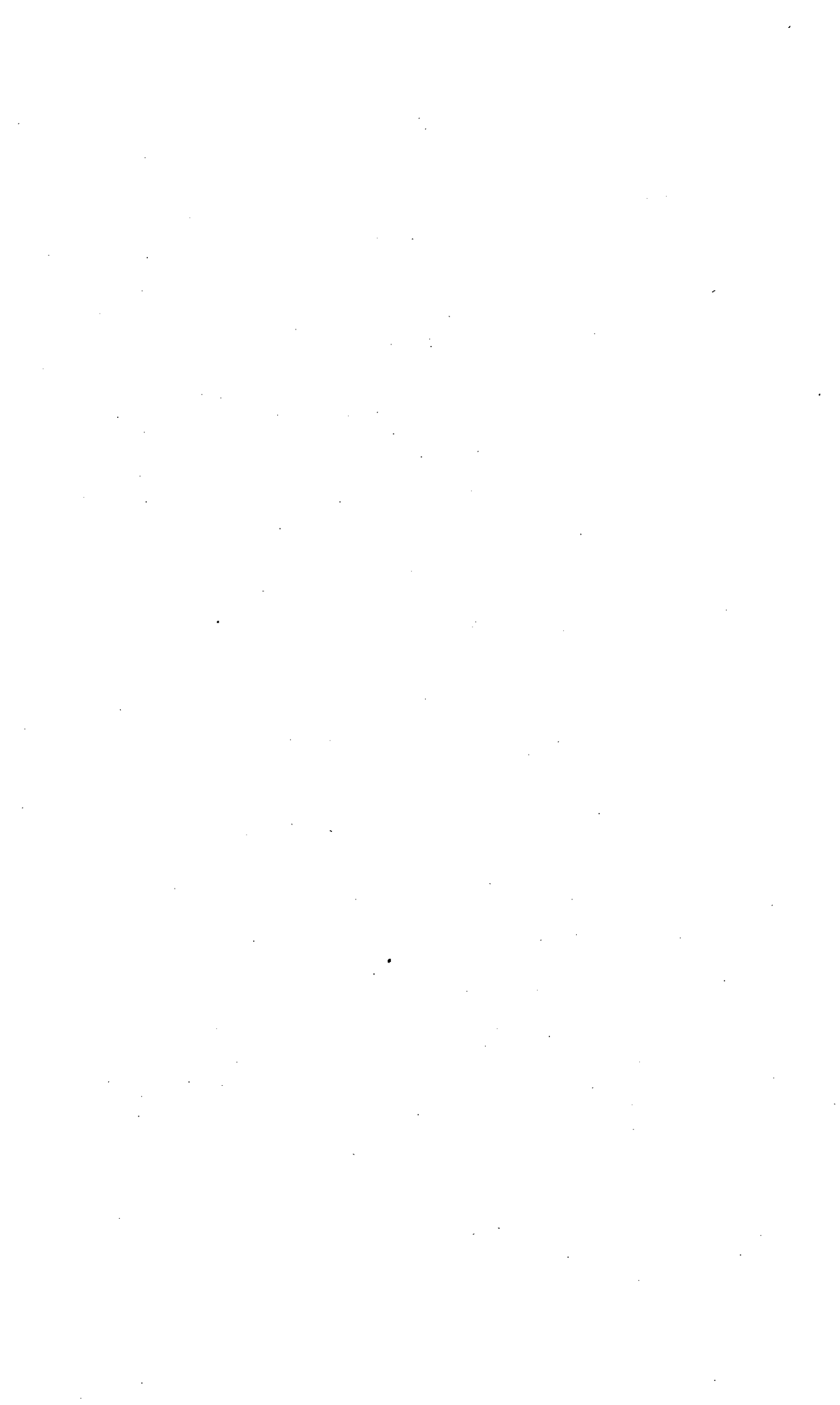

DEFAMATION BILL:—

Clauses 1 to 4 having been dealt with,—

Defamation.

1 Clause 5. Any imputation concerning any person, or any member of his family, whether living or dead, by which the reputation of that person is likely to be injured, or by which he is likely to be injured in his profession or trade, or by which other persons are likely to be induced to shun or avoid or ridicule or despise him, is called defamatory, and the matter of the imputation is called defamatory matter.

The imputation may be expressed either directly or by insinuation or irony.

Defamatory matter.
