Point of Order (Mr Ferguson), That the amendment was out of order as it was not within the order of leave given for the introduction of the bill, which seeks to amend the Crimes Act in respect of homosexual behaviour. The amendment relates to a person who solicits, procures or incites in relation to heterosexual acts as well as homosexual acts.

The Chairman stated that he had earlier ruled that the long title of the bill provides for an amendment to the Crimes Act, 1900, to decriminalize homosexual behaviour between consenting adults in private and for certain other purposes. The phrase "and for certain other purposes" is merely a savings phrase, and may be likened to a savings clause in a bill. It is not the main part of the long title. He ruled the amendment out of order.
