

REPORT OF THE JOINT STANDING COMMITTEE ON THE INDEPENDENT COMMISSION AGAINST CORRUPTION – REVIEW OF ASPECTS OF THE INDEPENDENT COMMISSION AGAINST CORRUPTION ACT 1988 (REPORT 6/57 – DECEMBER 2022)

GOVERNMENT RESPONSE

The Joint Standing Committee on the Independent Commission Against Corruption (**Committee**) self-referred an inquiry into the review of aspects of the *Independent Commission Against Corruption Act 1988* on 9 June 2022.

The Committee released its report (Report) on 15 December 2022.

The Government accepts both of the two recommendations made by the Committee which are directed to the Government.

The Government's position on each of the Committee's recommendations is set out in **Attachment A**.

Consistent with the commitment provided by the Leader of the Government in the Legislative Council to the Clerk of the Parliaments by letter dated 24 May 2023, the Government provides this response on a voluntary basis.
