

# Time limits for debate

**Note:** Not all motions have time limits, for example there are no time limits for debate on personal explanations or government motions not related to bills. Time limits apply only when they have been set by the relevant standing order.

## Government bills (SO 144)

### Second and third readings

Minister/Lead Opposition/  
first crossbench speaker: 40 mins  
All other speakers: 20 mins

Minister in reply: 20 mins

Note: A member may move that their time limit be extended by not more than 10 mins. Question is put without debate.

### Committee of the Whole

Speakers: 15 mins

Note: The member speaking may seek the leave of the Committee to continue speaking for a period of no longer than 15 mins.

## Private members' bills (SO 193)

### Leave to bring in bill

Debate: 60 mins  
Speakers: 10 mins

Debate interrupted ten minutes before end of debate time (ie. after 50 mins) to allow mover to speak in reply.

Mover in reply: 10 mins

### Second and third readings

Debate: no overall time limit  
Mover: 30 mins  
All other speakers: 20 mins  
Mover in reply: 20 mins

### Committee of the Whole

Speakers: 15 mins

## Question time (SO 64)

Question (or supplementary question): 1 min  
Answer: 3 mins  
Answer to supplementary: 2 mins

Note: A Minister may seek the leave of the House to extend the time for an answer by one minute.

## Private members' motions (SO 192(1))

Debate: 30 mins  
Mover: 5 mins  
Speakers: 3 mins

Debate interrupted after 30 mins to allow mover to speak in reply.

Mover in reply: 3 mins

## Take note of Answers to Questions (SO 69)

Debate: 30 mins  
Speakers: 3 mins

Debate interrupted after 30 minutes to allow a Minister to speak, if desired.

## Private members' long form motions (SO 192(2))

Debate: 120 mins  
Mover: 20 mins  
All other speakers: 15 mins

Debate interrupted after 120 mins to allow mover to speak in reply

Mover in reply: 5 mins

## Committee reports & government responses (SO 239)

Mover: 15 mins  
All other speakers: 10 mins

Mover in reply: 10 mins

## Members' statements (SO 43(2))

Debate: 30 mins  
Speakers: 3 mins

# Time limits for debate

## Disallowance motions (SO 82)

Debate:	90 mins
Mover/Minister:	15 mins
All other speakers	10 mins

Debate interrupted after 90 mins to allow mover to speak in reply

Mover in reply:	10 mins

## Cut-off dates for Government bills (SO 145)

### Question of urgency

Minister/Opposition:	10 mins
2 Crossbench members from different parties:	5 mins

## Declaring Council bills urgent (SO 146)

### Question of urgency

Minister/Opposition:	10 mins
2 Crossbench members from different parties:	5 mins

## Matters of Public Importance (SO 206)

### Question of urgency

Mover/Minister:	10 mins
-----------------	---------

### Debate

Debate:	90 mins
Mover/Minister/Lead Opposition*:	15 mins
All other speakers:	10 mins

Debate interrupted after 90 mins to allow mover to speak in reply

Mover in reply:	10 mins
-----------------	---------

\* Only when motion moved by a Government member

## Selection of Bills Committee Report (SO 141)

Debate:	30 mins
Speakers:	5 mins

Debate interrupted after 30 mins to allow mover to speak in reply.

Mover in reply:	5 mins
-----------------	--------

## Urgency Motions (SO 207)

### Question of urgency

Mover/Minister:	10 mins
-----------------	---------

### Debate

Mover/Minister/Lead Opposition*:	15 mins
All other speakers:	10 mins
Mover in reply:	10 mins

\*only when motion moved by a Government member

## Consideration of a document after tabling (SO 59)

Debate:	60 mins
Chair/Mover:	15 mins
All other speakers:	10 mins

Debate interrupted after 60 minutes to allow mover to speak in reply.

Mover in reply:	10 mins
-----------------	---------

## Suspension of standing orders (SO 204)

Debate:	30 mins
Speakers:	5 mins

### SSO for SO 52 or SO 55

Mover/Minister only:	5 mins
----------------------	--------

Debate interrupted after 30 mins. Mover cannot speak in reply.

## Ministerial statements (SO 50)

(count up/count down)

Minister:	no time limit
Opposition:	equal time to respond

## Adjournment of the House (SO 33)

Debate:	30 mins
Speakers:	5 mins
