

Chapter 1 Introduction

Referral of the 2015-2016 Budget Estimates

- 1.1 On 24 June 2015, the Legislative Council resolved that 'the Budget Estimates and related papers for the financial year 2015-2016 presenting the amounts to be appropriated from the Consolidated Fund be referred to the General Purpose Standing Committees for inquiry and report'. The resolution (hereafter referred to as the Budget Estimates resolution) requires each committee to examine the Budget Estimates for the relevant portfolios and report to the House by 18 December 2015.²
- 1.2 The Budget Estimates resolution further stipulated that the initial hearings will be held in the week commencing 31 August 2015 and the initial round of supplementary hearings be scheduled during the week of 6-9 October 2015.³

 - Friday 4 September 2015 Primary Industries, Lands and Water
 - Friday 4 September 2015 Environment, Heritage.

Chapter 2 Issues raised during the hearings

This chapter provides a brief summary by portfolio of the key issues raised during the hearings.

Industry, Resources and Energy

- 2.1 A hearing examining the portfolio of Industry, Resources and Energy was held on Wednesday 2 September 2015. The following issues were raised during the committee's examination of the Industry, Resources and Energy portfolio:
 - Cancellation of Metgasco's coal seam gas exploration license
 - Shenhua mine proposal in the Liverpool Plains area
 - Buy backs of petroleum exploration licenses
 - Pricing of electricity for consumers
 - NSW energy savings target for 2021 and related projects
 - Impact of changes to workers compensation legislation for coal miners
 - Licenses for fossickers and fossicking districts in NSW
 - Fines for electricity distribution companies relating to power outages without sufficient notice to households.

Primary Industries, Lands and Water

- A hearing examining the portfolios of Primary Industries, Lands and Water was held on Friday 4 September 2015. The following issues were raised during the committee's examination of the Primary Industries, Lands and Water portfolios:
 - Water loss due to breakages and leaks in the Sydney Water infrastructure pipeline
 - Sydney Water's submission to the Independent Pricing and Regulatory Tribunal relating to a reduction in water prices for users
 - Deer hunting and the use of spotlights
 - Role of RSPCA in prosecutions for animal cruelty
 - Review of the shark meshing program

- Chemical leak at Willamstown RAAF base, the Department of Primary Industries response and the impact on the community and commercial fisheries
- Impact of logging on koalas
- Complaint reporting for Local Land Services
- Review of Crown Lands legislation.

Environment, Heritage

- A hearing examining the portfolios of Environment, Heritage was held on Friday 4 September 2015. The following issues were raised during the committee's examination of the Environment, Heritage portfolios:
 - Groundwater contamination at Williamtown RAAF base
 - Native vegetation clearing
 - Biobanking
 - Kangaroo management and culling
 - Effect of government efficiency dividend requirement
 - National Environment Protection Measure standards.
