The Selection of Bills Committee met on Tuesday 22 February to consider whether the following bills be referred to a standing committee for inquiry and report:

- Crimes (Domestic and Personal Violence) Amendment (Coercive and Controlling Behaviour) Bill 2021
- Motor Sports Bill 2021
- Children and Young Persons (Care and Protection) Amendment (Family is Culture Review) Bill 2021
- COVID-19 and Other Legislation Amendment (Regulatory Reforms) Bill 2022
- Electronic Conveyancing (Adoption of National Law) Amendment Bill 2022

The committee makes the following recommendations:

- (1) That:
 - (a) the provisions of the Electronic Conveyancing (Adoption of National Law) Amendment Bill 2022 be referred to Portfolio Committee No. 4 for inquiry and report,
 - (b) the bill be referred to the committee upon receipt of the message on the bill from the Legislative Assembly,
 - (c) the committee report by 8 April 2022, and
 - (d) on the report being tabled, a motion may be moved immediately for the first reading and printing of the bill.
- (2) That the following bills not be referred to a standing committee for inquiry and report, this day.
 - (a) Crimes (Domestic and Personal Violence) Amendment (Coercive and Controlling Behaviour) Bill 2021,
 - (b) Motor Sports Bill 2021,
 - (c) Children and Young Persons (Care and Protection) Amendment (Family is Culture Review) Bill 2021, and
 - (d) COVID-19 and Other Legislation Amendment (Regulatory Reforms) Bill 2022.
