Questions on Notice

40. Review SRA employment grades, all incidence allowance and overtime

Suggested Response:

The Electorate Officers were covered by an Enterprise Agreement that expired on 1 July 1996 and negotiations between the PSA and the Speaker led to the Crown Employees (Parliamentary Electorate Officers) Award in 1997.

Investigation has revealed that the All Incidence of Employment Allowance rates were simply struck as follows:

- \$2500 pa for Electorate Officers Grade 1
- \$3000 pa for Special Salary Scale
- \$4000 pa for Electorate Officers Grade 2

These new All Incidence of Employment Allowance rates back in the day then flowed onto Secretary/Research Assistants.

Therefore, the rates were simply struck and not based on any data at the time ie. not based on any average hours overtime that Electorate Officers may have worked.

From 2014 when MOPS was established the two higher All Incident of Employment Allowance rates were attached to the new Classifications of Electorate Officer and Senior Electorate Officer and the higher rate flowed onto Secretary/Research Assistants.



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Those Allowance rates have risen with salary rate rises ever since to the current rates of \$6726 pa for EO's and \$8968 pa for SEO's and Secretary Research Assistant's.

In summary the All Incidence of Employment Allowance rate was not derived from the number of hours overtime worked.

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42. Number of people employed by Parliament with a disability

Suggested Response:

The number of staff who have identified as having a disability either requiring an adjustment or not is:

- DPS has 4 staff members who have identified as having a disability
- LC has 1 staff member who has identified as having a disability



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43. Accessibility and stairs into L9 garden

Suggested Response:

The lift at the front of the building provides access to the level 9 garden. Currently the lift runs at 0.5 of a meter per second. With changes in elevator technology there is a project that will take that up to 0.95 meter per second, nearly doubling the speed of that elevator allowing someone in a wheelchair can get to level 9 much faster. That is a short-term fix while DPS advocates for the funds to work with the steps from the level 9 tower block into the garden.



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44. Funding for Legislative Council committees

Suggested Response:

At the commencement of the Parliament, on the initiative of the Clerk, I approved the employment of an additional Director grade 11/12, two additional Principal Council Officers grade 9/10, one additional Senior Council Officer grade 7/8 and one additional Administration Officer grade 3/4 in anticipation of the additional workload. Additional funding of \$635K per annum was received in the 2019-2020 Budget to support these additional positions.

In addition, in advance of the delayed 2020-2021 budget, the committee received a further funding boost of \$440k per annum. This allowed the employment of two further Principal Council Officers grade 9/10, the employment of a second Council Officer grade 5/6 (senior administrative officer) and two additional Administration Officers grade 3/4.

Prior to Christmas, in view of the overall budget position of the Parliament, the Clerk authorised the temporary employment of an additional fifth Committee Director grade 11/12 for the duration of 2021. This was an absolutely necessary measure. Prior to that point, our Committee Directors had each been carrying 6 or 7 inquiries, which was not sustainable. I flag that given the workload of the Directors this fifth Director position may need to be continued in 2022.

In February, the Parliament submitted a budget bid for additional funding to extend the fifth Committee Director to the end of the Parliament and to employ additional Principal Council Officers grade 9/10 and an additional Administration Officer grade 3/4. The funding bid was for an additional \$450K over two years. We await the results of this funding bid.



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45. Improvements to the e-petition process including load balancing.

Suggested Response:

In July 2020 improvements were made to our servers to take a step towards ensuring the website and PIMS could handle expected peak loads during significant activity for committee inquiries (submissions) and electronic petitions (page views and signatures).

The results of the stress test showed a failure rate of 0.05% when the public website was tested to 36,000 hits per minute. The stress test also showed that the capacity of the website and PIMS to accept submissions improved more than 400% when compared to pre-load balancer state.

More recently, these load balancing servers were rebuilt to improve security and further testing undertaken.
