Ahead of our formal response could you please pass on to the Committee this clarification of evidence provided by Minister Tudehope.

On page 29 of the Transcript in answer to a question from Mr Shoebridge, Minister Tudehope gave a reply based, as he stated, on his “best recollection”:

Mr DAVID SHOEBRIDGE: And when were you a board member of the Catholic Cemeteries Board Ltd, which, as we both know, is the appointed reserve manager of the Crown trust, being the Catholic Metropolitan Cemeteries Trust?

The Hon. DAMIEN TUDEHOPE: To the best of my recollection, I resigned that position when I took on the role of chief of staff to the Attorney General in 2011.

After consulting his records Minister Tudehope wishes to advise the Committee as follows:

Minister Tudehope joined the Board on 9 July 2014 and resigned from the Board on 27 February 2015, prior to being elected to Parliament on March 28 2015.
