Subject: Clarification of evidence/transcript for Budget Estimates hearing

I write to advise of a clarification to evidence given by myself at the Budget Estimates hearing for Legislative Council Portfolio Committee No. 5 – Regional NSW and Stronger Communities, Families and Communities and Disability Services on Wednesday 2 March 2022.

Family Preservation Budget

Page 28, paragraph 8 of the transcript currently reads as:

'ANNE CAMPBELL: Okay. It is \$13.4 million for Family Preservation services, and that includes \$2.8 million for MST-CAN and FSP casework; \$2.6 million for Brighter Futures; \$3.3 million to Waminda - South Coast Women's Health & Welfare Aboriginal Corporation for the Nabu pilot program; \$129.4 million for the Permanency Support Program, and in that 14 Aboriginal community-controlled organisations plus four Aboriginal partnerships, and all those organisations also deliver the PSP Family Preservation packages; and there is obviously \$2.41 million to NSW Child, Family and Community Peak Aboriginal Corporation. That is as of June last year..'

This should be amended to:

Okay. Thank you, Mr Shoebridge. The annual budget for Family Preservation services is \$129 million which makes up 17% of the child protection budget, noting a proportion of the remaining child protection budget is also used to support families through case management and other practical supports with the aim of preventing entry to care.
