## Notes and costing assumptions

The policy proposes to provide capped grant amounts totalling \$4 million over the forward estimates to nongovernment organisations to fund three pilot projects. These projects will trial strategies to improve social and economic outcomes in spatially-concentrated Aboriginal populations, with a focus on addressing Aboriginal incarceration.

The costing assumes that funding will be allocated as follows: \$1 million in 2015-16, and \$1.5 million in 2016-17 and 2017-18.
