Notes and costing assumptions

This policy proposes to reduce expenditure on all consultants in the NSW General Government Sector by 20%, from 1 July 2019. The costing estimates a saving of \$75.1 million over the forward estimates.

Consultancy expenses represent the costs of a person or organisation engaged on a temporary basis to provide recommendations, high-level specialist advice or professional advice to assist management in decision making. Recurrent consultant expenses excludes consultancy costs associated with the delivery of capital projects as these are capitalised in the project costs.
