## Notes and costing assumptions

This policy proposes to allocate funding of \$20 million in 2019-20, \$15 million in 2020-21, \$15 million in 2021-22 and \$25 million in 2022-23 for active transport initiatives.

The policy would begin on 1 July 2019, and the funding is to be fixed and nominal. The policy assumes that two thirds of this funding is recurrent expenditure and one third is capital expenditure.

As the policy involves fixed payments, the PBO estimates the cost of the policy to be \$50 million over the forward estimates, with an additional \$25 million in 2022-23.
