## Notes and costing assumptions

The policy proposes to re-establish the Industrial Court of NSW. The cost of this policy is nil.

The Industrial Court of NSW was previously dissolved in 2016 and its jurisdiction transferred to the Supreme Court. The policy would require amending relevant legislation to transfer jurisdiction from the Supreme Court to the Industrial Court. As this is regulatory in nature and part of the normal business of government there is no net budget impact. The proposal assumes this cost can be met within existing agency resources, which the PBO considers feasible.
