## Notes and costing assumptions

The policy proposes to provide additional ongoing funding to support new rail infrastructure. The total cost of the policy is \$675 million over the forward estimates period, comprising fixed nominal amounts of \$150 million in 2019-20, \$275 million in 2020-21 and \$250 million in 2021-22.

The policy would continue to provide fixed amounts of \$350 million in 2022-23 and 2023-24 outside the forward estimates.

The PBO has excluded depreciation costs as infrastructure projects have not been specified.
