Notes and costing assumptions

The policy is to allocate \$1.625 million annually over four years from 2019-20 to 2022-23 to support the establishment of Western Sydney Airport as an export-orientated food and agribusiness precinct.

The PBO estimates the total cost of the policy is \$4.9 million over the forward estimates and \$6.5 million over four years from 2019-20.

The policy specifies that the funding is to be fixed and unescalated.
