## Notes and costing assumptions

This proposal will establish a specialist court for Indigenous offenders in the District Court jurisdiction.

This proposal specifies that most costs associated with this proposal will be funded through the reallocation of existing resources within the Department of Justice, and that existing facilities will be used. However, an additional \$1.5 million per annum (escalated by the Sydney CPI rate) will be allocated for additional therapeutic services following the establishment of the court.

Note that significant consultation would have to occur between the Department and the Indigenous community before this court could be established.
