## Notes and costing assumptions

This policy proposes allocating capital funding for hospital investments under the following profile:

- \$200 million in 2019-20,
- \$500 million in 2020-21,
- \$500 million in 2021-22,
- \$500 million in 2022-23, and
- \$500 million in 2023-24.

The policy is to begin on 1 July 2019, and the funding is fixed and nominal, and this funding would be in addition to any currently budgeted allocations.

The PBO estimates the cost of this policy to be \$1.2 billion over the forward estimates, and an additional \$1 billion over 2022-23 and 2023-24. Therefore, the total amount allocated would be \$2.2 billion over five years.
