## Notes and costing assumptions

This proposal is establishing a forward work plan of Health infrastructure capital spending totalling \$8.4 billion from 1 July 2019 to 30 June 2023.

The net total impact over the forward estimates is \$541.5 million, and the net additional funding to be provided under this proposal, beyond the allocations currently budgeted, is \$884.4 million until 2022-23.

This forward work plan also includes \$10 million for the refurbishment of palliative care facilities across NSW. However, this funding has been excluded from this costing as it will be delivered under the separate *Record Boost to Palliative Care Workforce in NSW* costing. Including this amount in the total, the net additional spend until 2022-23 is \$894.4 million.

The policy provides a list of additional projects receiving funding under this proposal in Appendix A.
