Notes and costing assumptions

The policy is to upgrade the amenity of 11 schools at a cost of \$7 million over the forward estimates and a further \$489,000 in 2022-23. The cost of the policy is \$7.4 million between 2019-20 and 2022-23.

The work proposed involves school upgrades including installation of solar panels, covered outdoor learning areas and upgrades to sports facilities and toilets.

The PBO has verified the individual project costings provided by the Department of Education against the cost and timing of similar projects. The PBO considers the cost and timing of cashflows to be reasonable.

The PBO assumes that the school upgrades do not incur additional operational costs (for example, salaries) or depreciation expense over the forward estimates.
