## Notes and costing assumptions

The policy proposes an additional \$8 million for Country University Centres to establish at least another five more centres across regional NSW. The PBO estimates that the cost of the policy is \$7.6 million over the forward estimates, with an additional \$400,000 in 2022-23. The policy states that funding will be absorbed within the Department of Industry's existing resources. As such, there is no net cost to this policy.

The 2018-19 Budget Paper No. 3 states that the Industry Cluster was allocated \$2.2 billion in 2018-19 to achieve the 'Skilled and employable workforce' outcome. The PBO considers the Department of Industry has the financial capacity to absorb the cost.
