The policy proposes to enter a 10-year Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) with religious communities on 1 April 2023 to make schools in NSW a safer space for all students and staff.

This MOU will bring the Department of Education, Multicultural NSW, and the Religious Communities Advisory Council together to create a unified approach to end racism, religious intolerance and discrimination against students and teachers.

The policy assumes the consultation and engagement costs required as part of the MOU can be met within existing resources. The Parliamentary Budget Office considers this would be feasible but may require a re-prioritisation of agency activities to implement the policy. Therefore, the impact of this policy is zero.
