Costing assumptions used:

Retail price of personal locator beacons ranges from \$100 to \$500. Assume bulk buy at \$250 (not \$500) per beacon for a total of \$125,000. Depreciate at 20% p.a. Employ one full-time equivalent staff at \$50,000 p.a. inclusive of on-costs, escalated at 2.5% p.a.

Provide funds for infrastructure from 2011-12 in two equal tranches. Depreciate track over ten years (not 20 assumed by Treasury).

Agency assumed to absorb costs of maintenance (estimated to be \$50,000 p.a.).
