Costing assumptions used:

Based on the information from the Department of Services, Technology and Administration and NSW Treasury, the Parliamentary Budget Office has assumed that a one off cost to provide a plain English information statement to potential buyers of manufactured homes and to develop a standard contract (also assumed to be in plain English) is estimated at \$3,000 and \$47,000 respectively.

The Department of Services, Technology and Administration has advised that the cost of free mobile conciliation services is estimated at \$100,000 (2010-11 dollars) per annum – escalated by 2.5 per cent per annum.

The Parliamentary Budget Office has assumed that free mobile conciliation services will commence in 2011-12.
