## Costing assumptions used:

Labor's expanded NSW Police Youth Command will be drawn from their police number commitment or from their existing police numbers, as such it has been assumed that financial impacts have already been included in the budget or other election time proposals affecting NSW Police Force.

\$4 million in funding to fix up ageing PCYC's costing has been based on Treasury advice that the funding will be provided over four years as a capital grant of \$1m p.a.

Extension of CREDIT trial program in Burwood and Tamworth to their local children's court initiative has been based on Treasury advice that this service can be provided by three officers at Grade 5/6 level.

It has been assumed that the extension will begin in 2011-12.

Starting salary for a Grade 5/6 officer is \$68,761 in 2010-11 and has been escalated by 2.5% each year.

20% on cost has been added to salary costs.

Brokerage cost has been assumed at \$30,000 p.a and has been escalated by 2.5% each year as per Treasury advice.

Create a whole of government early intervention system costing is based on Treasury costing. Salaries and infrastructure costs were provided by Treasury. The unit costs for the services are based on average unit costs for similar services in other jurisdictions.

Agency offset figures are based on Treasury calculated figures. These are based on research findings and models of the beneficial effects of early intervention.
