PBO assumes that legislative amendments would be required to restrict the availability and supply of tobacco. Any costs associated with the introduction of the Bill and awareness campaigns should be funded from the Department of Health or nominated agency's existing resources.

There is no information for the PBO to estimate the cost of the awareness campaigns.

Further supply restriction of tobacco may harm the retail sector, in terms of loss of revenue. There is no information, at this stage, for the PBO to fully cost the financial impact to the retail industry.
