Costing assumptions used:

All GPS devices will be acquired in the 2011-12 financial year.

100 units will be acquired at a cost of \$8,411 each. These units will be depreciated at a rate of 25% per annum. The annual maintenance cost for 100 units is \$163,200.

The total annual monitoring and service provider costs are \$15,650 for all offenders.

Recurrent costs are escalated at 2.5% per annum.
