## Costing assumptions used:

There will be \$400,000 for capital works in 2011-12, including \$380,000 for renovation of premises and \$20,000 for training materials.

The Pilot is assumed to end in 2014-15. The capital items will have no residual value at the end of the program and will therefore be depreciated at a rate of 33% per annum.

The recurrent component includes a single district court judge, three counsellors and ongoing training.

Counsellors are assumed to be on a payscale equivalent to two specialist psychologists and a senior specialist psychologist.

Repurposing the existing premises is assumed to have no net cost.

Recurrent costs are escalated at 2.5% per annum.
