## Costing assumptions used:

Information on this proposal, including estimated construction costs to convert the law courts building to a museum prepared by the Government Architect's Office, was provided by Communities NSW.

Design costs, submission of DA and tendering for a builder assumed to occur in 2011-12.

Construction assumed to occur in 2012-13 with the museum to commence operation in 2013-14.

Operating expenses provided by Communities NSW and include 20% salary oncosts.

Revenue provided by Communities NSW with no admission charges assumed.

Agency offsets come from the current Migration Heritage Centre budget assumed to be transferred to the new museum.

Estimates provided by Communities NSW were in 2011-12 terms, and so were escalated by forecast CPI of 2.5% p.a. for any later years.
